Commissioner Michael G. Regino was reappointed on 25 January 2019 as Member of the Social Security Commission (SSC).

On 18 June 2019 under the streamlined SSC Committees, he was designated chairperson of the Information Technology and Collection and member of the Risk Management and Investments. He was SSS' Nominee-Director in the Boards of Union Bank of the Philippines and Philex Mining Corporation for 2019.
