1	<p>On the Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC), we would like to clarify that it should be 50% of the total ABC?</p> <p>With that, we (Media Meter) would like to inform you that as much as we would love to join the bidding, the reason why we are unable to buy the bidding documents yet is because our SLCC as of now is only around 19% to 20% of the total budget amount.</p>	<p>Yes. The bidder must have completed within five (5) years prior to the deadline for the submission and receipt of bids, an SLCC that is similar to the contract to be bid, and whose value, adjusted to current prices using the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) consumer price indices, must be at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC.</p>
2	<p>In case that we are not able to join the bidding, does that mean that in case the other bidder can comply with the technical specifications, and they are the only sole bidder, does it mean that they will be automatically/technically the winner for the bidding?</p>	<p>No. If only one prospective bidder submitted its bid and it meets the eligibility requirements or criteria, after which it submits a bid which is found to be responsive to the bidding requirements, a Single Calculated and Responsive Bid (SCRB) shall be considered for award.</p>
