1	<p>Similar Contract</p> <p>Can we consider office supplies, computers, CCTV or laptop as similar contract?</p>	<p>We defined what a similar contract is, and that is per lot. That is our basis to tell us that you have capability to supply us with the equipment.</p>
2	<p>How do we know that the item is semi-expendable?</p>	<p>The project is composed of three (3) lots with specific categories that a bidder may choose to participate in.</p> <p>Lot 2 – Office Furniture Lot 3 – Audio/Video Equipment Lot 4- Electronic Equipment</p> <p>If the bidder chooses Lot 4, it shall have a similar contract for items in that lot.</p>
3	<p>Do we need to bid on all the items per lot or can we just bid on some items for that lot?</p>	<p>It is an all or nothing bids per lot. Bidders must bid on all the items per lot. If you fail to bid on one of the items on a particular lot, it is a ground for disqualification.</p>
4	<p>On the Technical Specifications is a column for an “Annex “, what should we put it?</p>	<p>For the annex portions are the proof of your compliance with the technical specifications on a particular item. It may be in the form of brochures or other literature.</p>
5	<p>Is the NFCC per lot?</p>	<p>Yes, it is per lot.</p>
6	<p>Can we bid on our preferred lot?</p>	<p>Yes.</p>
