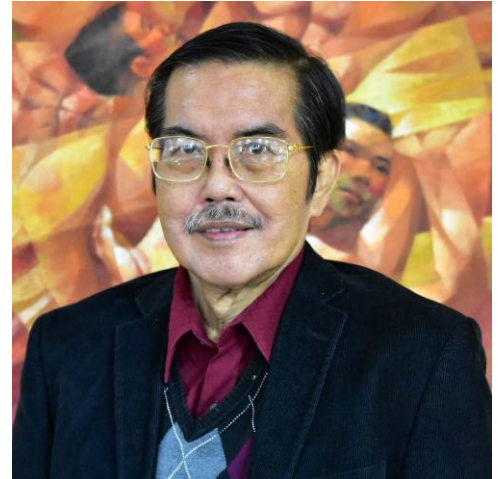

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF FUNCTION

As a member of the Social Security Commission (SSC), which serves as the Governing Board of the Social Security System (SSS), Commissioner Amansec shares the responsibility for the governance of the SSS, in terms of providing policy directions, monitoring and overseeing management actions and with powers and duties specified by Sec. 4 of Republic Act No. 8282 (The Social Security Act of 1997). He also performs quasi-judicial functions through the decisions rendered in cases involving disputes on SS coverage, benefits, contributions and penalties which fall under the exclusive jurisdiction of the SSC. He also chairs the Governance, Organization and Appointments Committee, and is a member of the Committee on Coverage, Collection and Other Related Matters and Investments Oversight Committee.
