BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF FUNCTION

As a member of the Social Security Commission (SSC), which serves as the Governing Board of the Social Security System (SSS), Commissioner Aguilar shares in the responsibility in the governance of the SSS in terms of providing policy directions, monitoring and overseeing management actions pursuant to the powers and duties granted under Republic Act No. 8282 (Social Security Act of 1997). She also performs quasi-judicial functions through the decisions rendered in the evaluation of cases involving disputes on SS coverage, benefits, contributions and penalties of which fall under the exclusive jurisdiction of the SSC.

Commissioner Aguilar is the Chairperson of the Investment Oversight Committee that oversees the SSS pension funds amounting to P465 Billion investment reserves as of October 2016 and the Information Technology Committee. She is likewise a member of Risk Management Committee and a resource person of the Audit Committee.

MAJOR ACHIEVEMENTS

As Chairperson of the SSS' Investment Oversight Committee, Commissioner Aguilar sets the direction in making strategic initiatives and policy reforms which contributed to generating a higher ROI in the investment performance of the SSS. Some of these reforms are synchronizing the renewal of accreditations; amending pertinent policy guidelines to enhance the transparency in selection of brokers and governance of investible funds.

From 2010 up to April 2016, Commissioner Aguilar was a Director of Security Bank and as such was part of the team that led SBC into making it as the bank with the highest return on assets (ROA) in the Asia Pacific region¹.
