

CONTRACT AGREEMENT

Three (3) Year Contract for Cargo Forwarding Services
(From Main Office to Foreign Destinations)
ITB-SSS-Goods-2022-048

THIS AGREEMENT made between:

SOCIAL SECURITY SYSTEM, a government-owned and controlled corporation created pursuant to Republic Act No. 11199, with principal office address at SSS Building, East Avenue, Diliman, Quezon City, represented herein by its Approving Authority and Vice President for Human Resource Services Division, **MA. NYMPHA M. RAGEL**, and Vice President for Benefits Administration Division and Concurrent Acting Head for International Operations Group, **JOY A. VILLACORTA**, duly authorized pursuant to Administrative Order No. 2022-032 dated 21 April 2022 (Annex "A") and Office Order No. 2022-026 dated 03 June 2022 (Annex "B"), hereinafter referred to as the "SSS";

WILLIAM N. BATAK, of legal age, Filipino, married, and duly authorized pursuant to an Omnibus Sworn Statement dated 02 August 2022 (Annex "C"), Sole Proprietor of BLUE CHIP MARKETING, with principal office address at 1441 Dagupan Street, Barangay 51 Zone 4 District 1, Tondo, Manila, hereinafter referred to as the "SUPPLIER".

WHEREAS, the SSS invited Bids for certain goods and ancillary services, particularly the **Three (3) Year Contract for Cargo Forwarding Services (from SSS Main Office to Foreign Destinations)** and has accepted a Bid by the SUPPLIER for the supply of those goods and services in the sum of **FOUR MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED NINETY-THREE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED NINETY-EIGHT AND 41/100 PESOS (P4,893,498.41)** for the first year or a total of **FOURTEEN MILLION SIX HUNDRED EIGHTY THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED NINETY-FIVE AND 22/100 PESOS (P14,680,495.22)** (hereinafter called "the Contract Price").

NOW, THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

1. In this AGREEMENT words and expressions shall have the same meanings as are respectively assigned to them in the Conditions of Contract referred to.
2. The following documents as required by the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184 shall be deemed to form and be read and construed as integral part of this AGREEMENT, viz.:
 - a. Philippine Bidding Documents including
 - i. Schedule of Requirements;
 - ii. Technical Specifications;
 - iii. General and Special Conditions of Contract; and
 - iv. Supplemental or Bid Bulletins, if any.
 - b. SUPPLIER's Bid, including –
 - Eligibility Requirements
 - i. PhilGEPS Registration
 - ii. Statement of Ongoing/Completed Contracts
 - iii. Omnibus Sworn Statement
 - Technical and Financial Proposal
 - iv. Single Largest Completed Contract
 - v. Bid Security
 - vi. Net Financial Contracting Capacity










- vii. Schedule of Requirements and Statement of Compliance
 - viii. Bid Form and Bid Breakdown
 - ix. Additional Documents (SEC Registration, Mayor's Permit, Audited Financial Statement, Income Tax Return, Tax Clearance, Quarterly VAT)
- c. Performance Security
 - d. BAC I Recommendation for Award under Resolution No. 2022-I-058-11 dated 06 September 2022, approved on 15 September 2022; Notice of Award of Contract dated 15 September 2022 and the **SUPPLIER's** conforme thereto; and
 - e. Other contract documents that may be required by existing laws and/or the SSS concerned in the PBDs. **Supplier agrees that additional contract documents or information prescribed by the GPPB that are subsequently required for submission after the contract execution, such as the Notice to Proceed, Variation Orders, and Warranty Security, shall likewise form part of the Contract.**
3. In consideration for the sum of **FOUR MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED NINETY-THREE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED NINETY-EIGHT AND 41/100 PESOS (P4,893,498.41)** for the first year or a total of **FOURTEEN MILLION SIX HUNDRED EIGHTY THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED NINETY-FIVE AND 22/100 PESOS (P14,680,495.22)** or such other sums as may be ascertained, **SUPPLIER** agrees to provide the Cargo Forwarding Services from SSS Main Office to Foreign Destinations for three (3) years in accordance with its Bid.
4. **SSS** agrees to pay the above-mentioned sum in accordance with the terms of the Bidding.




