

The Social Security Commission (SSC) is a collegial body that directs and controls the Social Security System (SSS), composed of the Secretary of the Department of Finance (DOF) who sits as *ex-officio* Chairperson, the SSS President and CEO/Vice Chairperson, the Secretary of Labor and Employment who sits as *ex-officio* Member, three (3) represent the workers' group, at least one of whom is a woman, and three (3) of whom shall represent the employers' group, at least one of whom is a woman

The SSC serves as the policy-making and governing board of the SSS. It also performs quasi-judicial functions over disputes arising under the Social Security Act with respect to coverage, benefits, contributions and penalties or related matters.
