- 1. The Pre-Bid Conference was called to order at 2:40 P.M.
- 2. The published Approved Budget for the Contract is P1,246,000.00.
- 3. The following observers were invited through BAC Notice dated 17 October 2019:
 - 3.1 Commission on Audit
 - 3.2 Anti-Corruption Training Center
 - 3.3 Anti-Trapo Movement of the Philippines, Inc.
 - 3.4 Makati Business Club
 - 3.5 Philippine Chamber of Commerce and Industry (PCCI)

However, none of them attended the activity.

- 4. Nobody paid/secured the Bidding Documents at the time of the Pre-Bid Conference.
- 5. The Technical Working Group (TWG) presented the background, scope of work, and technical specifications of the project.

6. The following issues/clarifications were raised during the Pre-Bid Conference:

6.1	Do the bidders need to include the application of income approach to value as a standard to income generating assets on the narrative report?	Yes.
6.2	Are all assets income generating?	Yes.
6.3	The bidder suggested that income- capitalization approach in arriving to value and apply it to correlation might result to a value pull down.	_
6.4	The bidder clarified if single proprietorship appraisal companies are qualified as independent appraisers since the requirement for appraisers must be BSP accredited. BSP only accredits corporations and other entities are only PARA members.	To be clarified through the Bid Bulletin.

- 7. The BAC Secretariat announced the Composition of Envelopes No.1 (Eligibility and Technical Documents) and No.2 (Financial Proposal), and additional documents.
- 8. The BAC I informed the bidders that the bid proposals will be subjected to Bid Evaluation. The bidder with the Lowest Calculated Bid (LCB) shall be required to submit the following additional documents within non-extendible period of five (5) calendar days from receipt of **BAC Notice:**
 - 2018 Income Tax Return (ITR) filed through Electronic Filing and Payment System (EFPS) corresponding to the submitted Audited Financial Statement;
 - Quarterly VAT for the period January to June 2019; b)
 - SEC/DTI Registration; c)
 - 2019 Mayor's Permit;
 - Valid Tax Clearance;
 - 2018 Audited Financial Statements filed through EFPS.
- 9. The BAC II emphasized that Sworn Statements/Affidavits/Certifications must be:
 - a) Signed by the Notary Public (attorney) himself/herself;
 - b) The Notary Public has an updated Authority to notarize, issued by the Regional Trial Court.
