Joined the SSS in 1984 as a regular contractual assigned at the Medical Department. After becoming a Certified Public Accountant that year, he was transferred to the Accounting Department where he was absorbed to the regular force in 1986. Thereafter, transferred to the newly created Internal Audit Service Department as an internal auditor. In 1990, he was promoted as Legal Officer at the Legal Department after passing the Bar Examinations. In 1999, he was appointed as Officer-in-Charge (OIC) of Makati Gil Puyat Branch, later as its permanent manager and stayed until 2010. He was promoted as Head (Asst. Vice President) of the Operations Accounting Division in June 2010 and Vice President in December 2016. At present, he is designated as Acting Head of the Administration Group effective September 3, 2019.
