CIRCULAR NO. 2020-017

TO : ALL SSS MEMBERS, CLAIMANTS, AND EMPLOYERS

SUBJECT : NUMBER CODING SYSTEM AND BRANCH SERVICING

GUIDELINES

In line with the government's directive for stringent social distancing measures amidst the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (CoViD-19) situation, and in the interest of public health and safety, the Social Security Commission (SSC) under its Resolution No. 359-s.2020 dated 08 July 2020, approved the Number Coding System and Branch Servicing Guidelines that will regulate the number of customers/visitors transacting in SSS branches.

In this regard, the following branch service procedures in handling transactions are hereby implemented in SSS branches nationwide:

I. Number Coding System

- A. Walk-in transactions shall be available **only** for the following transactions:
 - 1. Payment of contributions and loans;
 - 2. Compliance to SS Number Application through the SSS Web (i.e., Personal appearance, etc.);
 - Pick-up of UMID Card;
 - 4. Presentation of original document/s to support claim application;
 - Use of E-Center Facility (for those who have no computer/internet at home); and
 - 6. Other justifiable reasons.
- B. The following guidelines on the implementation of the Number Coding System are hereby issued:
 - The Number Coding System shall be implemented in all NCR Branches and in selected branches in Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao.

However, implementation may be suspended in these branches or imposed on additional branches, for justifiable reasons, subject to further announcement.

2. Number Coding/Prescribed Transaction Day

Customers/visitors shall transact with the SSS and shall be attended to on their prescribed transaction day, which shall be based on the last digit of their SS Number/Employer (ER) ID Number, as follows:

Last Digit of SS/ER ID Number	Prescribed Transaction Day
1 & 2	Monday
3 & 4	Tuesday
5 & 6	Wednesday
7 & 8	Thursday
9 & 0	Friday

Provided that, for Funeral/Death Benefit Claim, the SS number of the deceased member shall be the basis for number coding.

3. Exception Cases

- a. In case a holiday is declared on the prescribed transaction day, the member/ER may transact and shall be accommodated on the next working day, or the member/ER may opt to wait for their prescribed transaction day in the following week.
- b. In case of system downtime/offline, the branch shall set an appointment with members/ERs who are waiting in line, or at the option of the member/ER: (i) wait until system is operational/online; or (ii) come back the following week on their prescribed transaction day.
- II. For transactions other than those listed above, members/ERs shall be required to either submit their documents through the designated **DROPBOXES** or **CALL/TEXT/EMAIL** through the contact number/email address of the branch nearest their residence or place of work (Please refer to the advisory posted at the entrance of the branch).

Please be guided accordingly.
