QUERIES/CLARIFICATIONS RAISED DURING THE PRE-BID CONFERENCE:

	Query/Clarifications	BAC Reply
1	Will there be an inspection to be conducted inside the shop?	Yes.
2	Regarding the PMS, can we use other brands as long as they meet the specifications when it comes to engine oils/filter?	Yes. As long as it is included in the required specifications or its approved equivalent.
3	If during the process of PMS, we found out that there are other things to be repaired, is that included in the budget?	No. The supplier will only perform the services under PMS. They will provide a report on the vehicle that was serviced in their shop. Example, during the PMS, it was found out that brake pads are thin, they will recommend to SSS that brake pads are needed to be replaced. Repair works are not included in the PMS.
4	Is this the same with air-conditioning? Sometimes, we can spot problems during the general cleaning and replace whatever needs to be done. Usually, the problem would persist unless we conduct a more thorough check-up. In this case, what will be our action?	The winning bidder will only do general cleaning and not the repair. The vehicle intended for PMS will be diagnosed first and if issues are found to be not in the scope of works for this project, cleaning will not be conducted. No repairs or servicing to be done.
5	For the single largest completed contract (SLCC), is the required number of years, 5 years?	Yes. Bidder must have a contract that is similar to the contract to be bid within the last five years prior to the submission and opening of bids.
6	Can we show other lists of clients under the same service? Having this project is rare for us.	Yes, if it is within the last 5 years prior to the submission and opening of bids.
7	What we have are individual clients and not necessarily contracts. This is what I want to be cleared.	If it is an individual client, a job order may be provided since it is also similar to a contract. At least one contract equivalent to at least 50% of the ABC and within 5 years prior to the submission and opening of bids.
