	Query/Clarifications	TWG/BAC Reply
1	Do we have to pay for another Bid Docs fee if we already purchased before?	No need to pay for Bid docs fee if you already purchased in the previous bidding process
2	For the List of ongoing of projects, do we need to attach a supporting document?	Only list of Ongoing Project is needed.
3	Is the valuation fee also included in the bid offer or it will be billed on top of the freight charges?	Valuation fee is included in the bid offer.
4	Will you consider a subcontractor? We do have a third-party logistic provider, but we are still responsible and have obligation for the whole service process.	No, subcontracting is not allowed.
5	Even the packing and crating of the items is inclusive in the bid offer?	The packing and crating will be shouldered by the service provider.
6	Regarding the Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC), are we basing the 50% from the total ABC or from the yearly breakdown? Will you consider 25% as an SLCC?	The fifty percent (50%) will be based on the total ABC which is ₦47,481,816.37. We only allow 50% of the ABC.
7	Regarding the PHILGEPS Certificate, can we attach upon the Submission of Bids, PHILGEPS Certificate only then to follow if ever the other documentation needed during the post-qualification process?	Yes, upon Submission of Bids, only PHILGEPS Certificate is required. Additional documents shall be required for submission if you are declared as the lowest calculated bidder.

8	<p>Is it considered as an SLCC if the project was extended? Technically, the contract was already finished but the procuring entity requested an extension.</p>	<p>Yes, as long as you have secured a Certificate of Final Acceptance.</p>
9	<p>Will SSS provide the service provider with the schedule and list of the items to be delivered?</p> <p>Also, the suppliers may be given a number of days' notice since they are in charge of the packing and crating of items to be delivered.</p> <p>Is this going to be daily a requirement? Pertaining to the two (2) required personnel.</p> <p>Will you be needing supporting document to be attached for the two assigned personnel regarding the updated contribution of government contribution?</p>	<p>Yes, SSS will provide the schedule and list of the items to be delivered.</p> <p>Yes, SSS will notify the service provider.</p> <p>It is also required that the service provider designate at least two (2) personnel in the SSS.</p> <p>It is stipulated in the Bid Documents that the personnel assigned must be updated in the government contribution but there is no need to attach any supporting documents or proof regarding that.</p>
10	<p>Will you be providing the service provider the consolidated list of the personnel responsible together with their contact details in receiving the item for each location?</p>	<p>Yes.</p>
11	<p>The service provider and supplier in the Bid Documents is referring to the winning bidder?</p>	<p>Yes.</p>
12	<p>Regarding the SLCC, it is stated to be completed in the last ten (10) years prior to the Submission of the Bids, only one (1) contract will be the basis to comply for the fifty percent (50%)?</p> <p>Will you consider two contracts from the same client as SLCC?</p>	<p>Yes.</p> <p>We only accept one contract for the SLCC.</p>

13	Regarding the SLCC it is indicated that the project should be without a Non-Disclosure Agreement. What if we have a Certificate of Completion provided on the project but it is only considered as non-disclosure because our partner is International. Will you consider that?	We cannot accept that specific project as we might receive no confirmation/ validation from your partner during the post-qualification process.
14	For clarification, the SLCC you mentioned in the presentation have been completed for the last five (5) years but in the Bid Documents it is stated for the last ten (10) years.	The one stated in the Bid Documents will prevail, which is 10 years.
