Must have at least dual 10-core Central Processing Units (CPUs), Complex Instruction Set Computing (CISC/x64), and a high-end GPU."</p> <p>For "high-end GPU", may we request TWG to consider GPU intended for the server to support its functionality as a "Application and Network Performance Monitoring"?</p>	Yes.
2	<p>Page 22, under "Application and Network Performance Monitoring",</p> <p>For us to come up with a financial bid proposal, may we ask for the following information below:</p> <p>1. The number of Applications / Websites to be monitored?</p> <p>2. The number of network devices to be monitored?</p>	<p>More than 70 internal applications and 9 external websites are currently running, including those automatically discovered by SPMT, with additional applications to be integrated as new projects are implemented.</p> <p>Over 280 network devices from the Main Data Center and Disaster Recovery Site are currently included for monitoring, with additional devices to be integrated as new projects are implemented.</p>
3	<p>Page 23, under "Server Monitoring",</p> <p>May we know the number of Servers to be subjected for Monitoring?</p>	Over 40 servers from the Main Data Center and Disaster Recovery Site are currently included for monitoring, with additional servers to be integrated as new projects are implemented.
4.	<p>Page 23, under "Database Monitoring",</p> <p>May we know the number of Database instances to be monitored?</p>	There are 4 databases, each with 2 instances, which means 8 database instances need to be monitored.
5.	<p>Page 23, under “Firewall and Web Application (WAF) Monitoring.</p>	Firewall 2 – Main Data Center 1 – Disaster Recovery Site

	May we know Firewall and WAF count?	Web Application Firewall 2 – Main Data Center 2 – Disaster Recovery Site
6.	<p>Page 16. ITB Clause 5.3 For this purpose, contracts similar to the Project shall be:</p> <p>a. Supply, delivery, and installation of Application Performance Monitoring or Network Performance Monitoring System with Network Packet Broker.</p> <p>b. Completed within seven (7) years prior to the deadline for the submission and receipt of bids.</p> <p>As an alternative to the standard SLCC requirement, please consider projects that are 50% of the ABC in value, completed, accepted, and fully paid but still under warranty.</p> <p>We believe that the objective of the Single Largest Completed Contract is to ensure that bidders have a proven track record and experience, demonstrating their ability to successfully complete projects similar to the one being bid, hence we are appealing to SSS to please consider our request above</p>	<p>The requirement for the SLCC is that the single largest completed contract must be supported by a certificate of satisfactory completion, confirming that all project deliverables, including the warranty period have been fulfilled.</p>
