A. QUERIES/CLARIFICATIONS RAISED DURING THE PRE-BID CONFERENCE:

	Query/Clarifications	TWG/BAC Reply
1	The SLCC number of years indicated in the Data Sheet is 8 years; however, in Paragraph 5.4 of the Instructions to Bidders, the number of years indicated is 10 years. Which one should we follow?	It should be eight (8) years; we will correct it in the Bid Bulletin.
	There is also a discrepancy in the ABC indicated in the Bidding Documents—Price Schedule Form (Page 79). The amount stated in the Price Schedule Form is ₱9,259,110.00.	We will change it to ₱5,596,800.00 . This appears to be an error—the amount written here must belong to another project.
2	The Submission and Opening of Bids is scheduled for February 25, 2026, which might be a holiday.	If that day is declared a non-working holiday, we will issue a Bid Bulletin to move the schedule of the Submission and Opening of Bids.
3	Regarding the Technical Specifications, we would like to clarify whether the requirement is strictly for a monitor, and if we are not allowed to bid a TV.	Yes, a television is allowed.
	As long as we provide all the features specified in the Technical Specifications, supplying only a monitor is not required.	Yes, even if it is a Smart TV.
4	For the documents, are we required to include attachments in the Statement of Ongoing Government and Private Contracts or not?	There are no supporting documents required.
	To clarify, although it is already indicated in the Bid Data Sheet, the only requirement for Bid Security is a Bid Security Declaration.	We will discuss it later in the documentary requirements.
5	Does the 90-day period include deployment in regions?	Yes.
	Regarding the inspection, the 200 units will be inspected at SSS Main Office before being delivered to different regions, or will the inspection be conducted per region?	The first inspection will be conducted in your warehouse, and after delivery to the regions, another inspection will take place.
6	Will the monitors be used only for displaying announcements in your offices?	The monitors will be used for displaying announcements, infomercials, and presentations.
	Will the monitors be mounted on the walls?	It should have a stand and can be mounted on the walls.
	Should the delivery include the stand and the tools required for wall mounting?	Yes.

7	What will we do during the pre-screening of documents?	We will check the completeness of all the documents enclosed in envelope number one (1).
	Do we need to bring it to your office?	Yes.
