Ongoing/Continuous Professional Education Programs for the SSC Commissioners

Under Section 27, third paragraph (b) of the Manual of Corporate Governance for the Social Security System — which was approved under Social Security Commission (SSC) Resolution No. 138 dated 24 February 2016, “the SSC shall provide ongoing or continuous professional education and training programs for SSC Members and Commission officers.”

Pursuant to said policy, the Office of the Commission Secretary, Compliance Officer and Executive Commission Clerk coordinated with the SSS Learning and Development Department (LDD) for the participation of the SSC Members in various seminars and trainings and for the conduct of several in-house seminars/trainings for the SSC Members such as the Executive Briefing on Gender and Development (20 June 2025) by the SSS LDD, the SSS Strategy Refresh Program (17 October 2025) by the SSS Management Services and Planning Division, the Briefing on Republic Act No. 12009 (12 November 2025) by the SSS Procurement Management Division.

Beyond structured seminars, the SSC Members’ professional development is further enriched by deep-dive presentations from management during its meeting. In compliance with the SSC directive on 12 February 2025 to present the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 12009, or the New Government Procurement Act, including a comparative matrix against the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184, or the Government Procurement Reform Act, the Management then presented the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of R.A. No. 12009 (New Government Procurement Act) on 26 February 2025 during the SSC meeting.

In compliance with the SSC directive on 04 June 2025 to report on how Malaysia administers its social security programs and how the SSS compares with Malaysia, the Management then presented the Malaysia’s Pension Policy and Management during the SSC meeting on 26 November 2025.
