**BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF FUNCTION**

She assists the Social Security Commission (SSC) in the performance of its policy-making, quasi-judicial and administrative functions; prepares and keeps the Minutes of Meetings of SSC and its Committees, among other duties and responsibilities. As Acting Commission Secretary, Compliance Officer and Executive Commission Clerk and Deputy Commission Clerk, she supervises the Commission Secretariat Department, the Policy Research and Governance Department, and the Commission Legal Departments.

She passed the 2012 Bar Exams. She is also a Career Executive Service Officer IV.

From 02 January 2024 to 2025, she served as Director IV at the Presidential Management Staff, Malacañang, Manila, where she provided senior-level policy support and coordination for executive decision-making at the Office of the President. From 18 February 2013 to 01 January 2024, she worked at the Governance Commission for Government-Owned or -Controlled Corporations, where she held various positions of increasing responsibility. During her tenure, she headed the Compensation and Position Classification System Secretariat, which was responsible for the development and implementation of the first standardized compensation and position classification system for GOCCs. From 11 January 2013 to 03 January 2014, she served as a Professor at Cavite State University, Indang, Cavite, teaching courses related to public administration and governance. Earlier, from 06 July 2009 to 12 November 2010, she held the position of Presidential Staff Officer II at the Presidential Management Staff, Malacañang, Manila, where she assisted in policy coordination, research, and executive support functions. From 05 November 2007 to 27 February 2009, she worked as a Researcher at the National College of Public Administration and Governance (NCPAG), University of the Philippines Diliman, Quezon City, conducting research on public sector governance and administrative reforms. Her public service career began at the local level when she served as Sangguniang Kabataan Councilor of Alulod, Indang, Cavite, from 01 August 2002 to 31 October 2007, where she was actively involved in youth leadership and local governance initiatives.
